

## Radio Broadcasting Service Licence

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF LICENCE

#### Conditions:

1. The licensee shall comply with the provisions of the Swaziland Posts and Telecommunications Corporation Act No 11 of 1983, its regulations, international conventions by which Swaziland is bound and any other laws currently in existence in Swaziland.
2. The licensee shall be a legal person.
3. The Licensee shall not assign, sublet or otherwise dispose of the licence without the written consent of the Regulator.
4. The licensee shall comply with national policies, laws and regulations currently in existence or that may be promulgated or enacted.
5. The licensee shall exercise due care and responsibility in the presentation of programmes where a large number of children are likely to be part of the audience.
6. The station shall not be used for political purposes against Swaziland or any other State, nor shall it be used to promote any political ideology, agenda, organization or message without the authority of the Minister responsible for Information
7. The licensing authority shall have the right to conduct inspections at the station and retrieve any broadcasting material as and when necessary.
8. The station shall commence operations within 3 months from date of licence issuance.
9. The licensee shall operate only in the coverage authorised by the Regulator.
10. Annual fees-
  - a. For a community radio service E2500
  - b. For a commercial radio service- E10000 for the first year, and for subsequent year E10000 or 3% of the Net Operating Income (NOI)
  - c. Spectrum- E500 per transmitter
11. Application Fees-
  - a. For a community radio service E250
